GETTING AROUND TUCSON:

To Access These Central Tucson Streets:

Prince Road	6th Street/St. Mary's Road
Miracle Mile	Broadway Boulevard/Congress Street
Grant Road	22nd Street/Starr Pass Boulevard
Speedway Boulevard	29th Street

From Phoenix, exit at Prince Road (254); and travel the frontage road.

From El Paso, exit at 29th Street (259); and travel the frontage road.

From Nogales, exit at 29th Street (102); and travel the frontage road.

I-10 is open with two lanes in each direction.

Frontage roads are open with three lanes in each direction.

- Extensive directional signs.
- Easy access to all central Tucson destinations.
